Dual Credit Student Eligibility at NMSU - Main Campus

NMSU Main Campus - Dual Credit Eligibility

- Junior or Senior - enrolled at least half time at high school
- High school GPA of **3.0**
- ACT Composite = **23** or
SAT = **Total Score = 1130 (Combined Critical Reading and Math)**
- If juniors, new to the program, have not had the opportunity to take the ACT/SAT, then we will accept the PSAT or the PLAN for their first semester. A student must have the following PSAT/PLAN score:

PSAT = **860 (Total Score)**
PLAN = **18**

****This PSAT/PLAN score will only be good for one semester.** In order for the student to continue on to their 2nd semester in the program, they will need an ACT/SAT on file.

- Student must maintain a cumulative NMSU GPA of 2.0 and a high school GPA of 3.0 to continue in the program.
